

ARTICLE VII  
Officer Vacancies

- Section 1. Should a vacancy , resignation or incapacitation occur to the Alumni President, the Vice President shall assume the role of President and shall convene a meeting of the Executive Committee to secure a replacement. A motion and vote will be held at the next banquet business meeting to approve the nomination of the Executive Committee or take nominations from the floor, providing approval of nominee from the floor has been secured in advance.
- Section 2: Should a vacancy occur in the Newsletter Editor/Vice President position the President, with approval of the Executive Committee, shall appointment an alumni in good standing to fill this position. A motion and vote will be held at the next banquet business meeting to approve the nomination.
- Section 3: Offices of Haddam Alumni Secretary and Treasurer may be served by the President or may be appointed by the President as his/her designee. Said designee to serve at the pleasure of the President.
- Section 4: The office of Newsletter Editor/Vice President will serve at the pleasure of the President.

SECTION VIII  
Amendments

These By-Laws may be amended by submitting proposed changes in writing to the President or at the suggestion of the President. The proposed amendment changes must appear in the Newsletter, or published on a Haddam website, before the President brings it to the Annual Meeting. Changes must be approved by a two-thirds vote of the members present at the Annual Meeting.
